

59° Abierto Mexicano Qualifying Tournament

Eligibility:

- Entries are open to all Professional and Amateur Golfers with an up-to-date men's Handicap Index not exceeding 3.0, under the FMG/USGA Handicap System, who wish to obtain a place to compete in the 59° Abierto Mexicano.

Entry Procedures:

- All entries must be completed and received by the 59° Abierto Mexicano Committee by 13:00 hrs. on March 17, 2018. A copy of the deposit or electronic transfer must accompany all entries. Entries without payment will not be accepted. No entry will be included in the draw unless complete in every detail:
 - a) Entries must be made on line at the 59° Abierto Mexicano registration website: <https://www.golfgenius.com/ggid/uwsmfz>, selecting the event and completing the registration page.
 - b) The entry fee is \$100.00 U.S. (One hundred US dollars) for members and \$200.00 US (Two hundred US dollars) for non-members and amateur players.

Withdrawals:

If a player withdraws from the event on March 19, 2018, their withdrawal is final. The player will forfeit their entry fee.

Format:

- o Stroke Play
- o 18 holes.

Note: Maximum field of 84 players plus PGA Tour Latinoamerica players with no exempt status.

1. The eight (8) best scores of the qualifying tournament will qualify for the **59° Abierto Mexicano**, from March 22 to 25. In the event of a tie for the 8th spot, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff, to be played over holes decided by the Qualifying Tournament Committee.
2. The tournament field will be filled with alternate spots, starting with members with a PGA Tour Latinoamerica conditional card and then with the alterns of the qualifier tournament, **in the event that the tournament field is less than 132 players.**
3. The players, who obtain a spot, will have to follow the registration procedure with the **59° Abierto Mexicano** Organizing Committee. Please contact Federico Valdez fvaldez@fmg.org.mx or Gina Mendoza gmendoza@fmg.org.mx or by phoning: +52 1 55 4340 8203 & +52 1 55 4393 5084, and they will have to pay \$20.00 US dollars (Twenty US dollars) to the PGA Tour Latinoamerica for insurance purposes.
4. Starting times will be from 8:00 am onwards and will be posted on Sunday, March 18 at the club house and on the web page: <https://www.golfgenius.com/pages/12535198>

6. All players must comply with the club politics holding an official document for identification to be able to gain access to the golf club.
7. The PGA Tour Latinoamerica will decide on the altern players, accordingly with the PGA Tour Latinoamerica tournament regulations.

Amendments:

The Qualifying Tournament Committee reserves the right to amend these tournament conditions.

Conditions of Competition

Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf adopted by the Mexican Golf Federation, FMG, and the Local Rules authorized by the Organizing Committee.

Tees: FMG

One Ball Rule: During a stipulated round, the balls a player plays must be of the same brand and model as detailed by a single entry on the current list of conforming balls. **Penalty for breach of condition:** Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round – Four strokes (two strokes at each of the first two holes at which any breach occurred).

Distance-Measuring Devices: In this competition, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

Transportation: Players shall walk at all times during a stipulated round, except in the holes authorized by the Committee.

Dress: Shorts, bermudas and jeans are not permitted.

Close of Competition: The competition is considered to have closed when the results has been posted.

Suspension of Play:

Discontinue play immediately: One prolonged note of siren;

Discontinue play: Three consecutive notes of siren, repeated;

Resume play: Two short notes of siren, repeated.
