### Eligibility:

- Amateur golfers with a MGF/USGA handicap index of less than 2.9
- Golfers who do not have a MGF/USGA handicap must provide proof of a recognized handicap index. The Committee reserves the right to verify the veracity of said handicap index and to inform the player of its acceptability.
- The field is limited to 144 players and places will be assigned in the order in which registrations are processed.

As an eligibility requirement, the MGF National Rules Committee must oversee the club championship.

\* Players receiving a formal invitation from the MGF must meet championship eligibility requirements and pay the tournament entry fee.

- Entry fee: \$11,500.00 (Eleven Thousand Five Hundred Mexican pesos 00/100 M. N.).

  - Proof of MGF/USGA handicap index or equivalent.

Registrations will only be considered accepted and confirmed as long as they receive an email with their confirmation.

- Entries will close on May 21, 2021, or earlier if the tournament is full (144 players). The only registration guarantee is the deposit slip.

The criteria for assigning places for those players who are eligible and who are on the waiting list for the "CXIII México Internacional Amateur" will be the following:

1. Position in the WAGR as of May 21, 2021
2. Champion CXII MIA
3. Best place in the CXII MIA
4. Individual Champion of the 2020 Interclub National Championship
5. Champion Couple, National Couples Championship 2020
6. Individual Champion, 2020 Men's Interzone National Championship
7. Best CNIJ Ranking 2020 - 2021
8. National Champion "LXX National Junior Youth Championship presented by Carlos Ortiz"



- 9. Best place in the "LXX National Junior Youth Championship presented by Carlos Ortiz"
- 10. Winner category 18 years and under in the last:
  - Copa Zona Centro
  - Copa Zona Norte
  - Copa Valle de México
  - Copa Yucatán
- 11. Individual Champion CXII Campeonato Nacional Interzonas "Lorena Ochoa"
- 12. Champion indoor / annual tournaments main category of clubs and fields affiliated to the FMG.

### Championship format:

- "XCIII Mexico International Amateur"
  - Stroke play
  - 72 holes
  - 54-hole cut: the best 60 scores plus ties.
  - Ties for first place will be settled by means of a hole-by-hole play-off; holes to be designated by the Championship Committee.
  - Ties for second and third places will be settled by comparing scorecards: first, the lowest aggregate team score for the third round; if there is still a tie, the lowest aggregate team score for holes 10 to 18 (the back nine); if there is still a tie, the lowest aggregate team score for holes 13 to 18; if there is still a tie, the lowest aggregate team score for holes 16 to 18, and thereafter the 18<sup>th</sup> hole. If there is still a tie, the same process will be applied to the second-round scores and, if necessary, to the first-round scores.
- "XIX International Mexican Pairs Tournament"
  - Stroke play, aggregate team scores
  - 54 holes
  - No cut
  - Ties for first, second and third places will be settled by comparing scorecards: first, the lowest aggregate team score for the third round; if there is still a tie, the lowest aggregate team score for holes 10 to 18 (the back nine); if there is still a tie, the lowest aggregate team score for holes 13 to 18; if there is still a tie, the lowest aggregate team score for holes 16 to 18, and thereafter the 18<sup>th</sup> hole. If there is still a tie, the same process will be applied to the second-round scores and, if necessary, to the first-round scores.

Practice tee: The practice tee will be open and available to players as of Monday June 7. However, the course will be closed before the official practice round.

Official practice round: Tuesday June 8 as of 7:00 a.m.

Close of the Competition: The competition will be deemed to have closed when the championship trophy has been awarded to the winner.

### Prizes:

  - An **exemption from qualifying for the next "U.S. Amateur Championship"**;
  - An exemption from local qualifying for the next **"U.S. Open"**.
- Second and third place winners in the "XCIII Mexico International Amateur" will receive:
  - A replica of the institutional championship trophy.



- The best Mexican in the “XCIII Mexico International Amateur” will receive:
  - A medal
  - An exemption for the 62th Mexican Open\*\*.
- The winners of the first three places in the “XIX International Mexican Pairs Championship” will receive:
  - Trophies.

\*\* The player must conserve his amateur status.

#### Transportation:

As of Tuesday June 8, official transportation will be provided in both directions between the host hotel and the Club Campestre Torreón.

#### Tee times:

First and second round tee times will be announced at the host club (MGF office, locker room and the pro shop) on Wednesday June 8 at 6:30 p.m. They will also be posted on the MGF website ([www.fmg.org.mx](http://www.fmg.org.mx)).

#### Caddies:

- Caddies are not mandatory but will be available for players if required.
- In the event of hiring a caddie, players will be responsible for paying **the host club’s 18-hole fee** of \$500 Mexican pesos directly to the caddie.
- In the event of bringing your own caddie, please inform the Committee and sign him in, in accordance with host club regulations. For further information, please contact the pro shop at the club.

#### Club house:

- The Club Campestre Torreón will open its doors from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. from Monday to Saturday, and from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Sunday during the week of the XCIII Mexico International Amateur.
- At all times, players must wear the personal ID given to them at registration.
- **Players bearing official ID will have access to the gentlemen’s locker room and players’ dining room (Comedor de Jugadores)** in the clubhouse.
- The Federación Mexicana de Golf will provide a complimentary breakfast and buffet lunch for players in the area designated **players’ dining room** (Comedor de Jugadores) in the club house.
- Companions bearing **official ID will have access to the players’ dining room and will be given a special price** for the buffet service during the event (Thursday to Sunday).
- The Club Campestre Torreón will provide lockers for members of the teams competing the in the XIX International Mexican Pairs Tournament. The number of lockers is limited and will be assigned to other players if available.
- Player will be able to make use of the golf equipment storage facility.
- Dollars, VISA and MasterCard cards are welcome in the clubhouse.
